Y6 returning to school

Following the government announcement yesterday that we have met the five tests we are delighted to start our phased return back to school. As, explained in the previous letter we will be inviting in the youngest pupils in year 6 initially taking a phased approach. Legible pupils will be contacted by 'My Ed' today. We ask politely that you respond to the text to let us know if you intend on sending your child to school.

Please access school from the side lane, near the Post Office, entering the side gate where your children will be met by a member of staff. The gate will be opened from 8.40 am and children will be dismissed at 2.30 pm.

Can you please send your child in a school polo, jumper or white t-shirt. The children will be accessing P.E lessons. However, they will not be getting changed at school so please send them appropriate foot wear.

They will need to bring with them a named bottle of water and where possible a mini hand sanitiser to keep at their designated desk. If your child usually purchases a school dinner they will need to bring a packed lunch.

Aston Lodge Primary recognises the impact 'lockdown' may have had and the social isolation it has brought to many young people and families. I am sure that pupils will have missed spending time with their 'schoolmates', both in and out of school!

Rest assured, all staff in school will be vigilant as your children return to school and will act promptly should they see any changes in your child's behaviour or emotions – this may be displayed in a range of different ways, all of which could be an indication of an underlying problem.

Pastoral staff in school will continue to have dedicated time to ensure the welfare and safety of all children and will access advice, guidance and resources from other welfare agencies to support children's mental health and well-being.

The school may signpost children experiencing well-being issues to the appropriate support partners for example; school based Learning Mentor, the 'With Me in Mind' team (<http://www.withmeinmind.co.uk/>) or the School Learning mentor.
