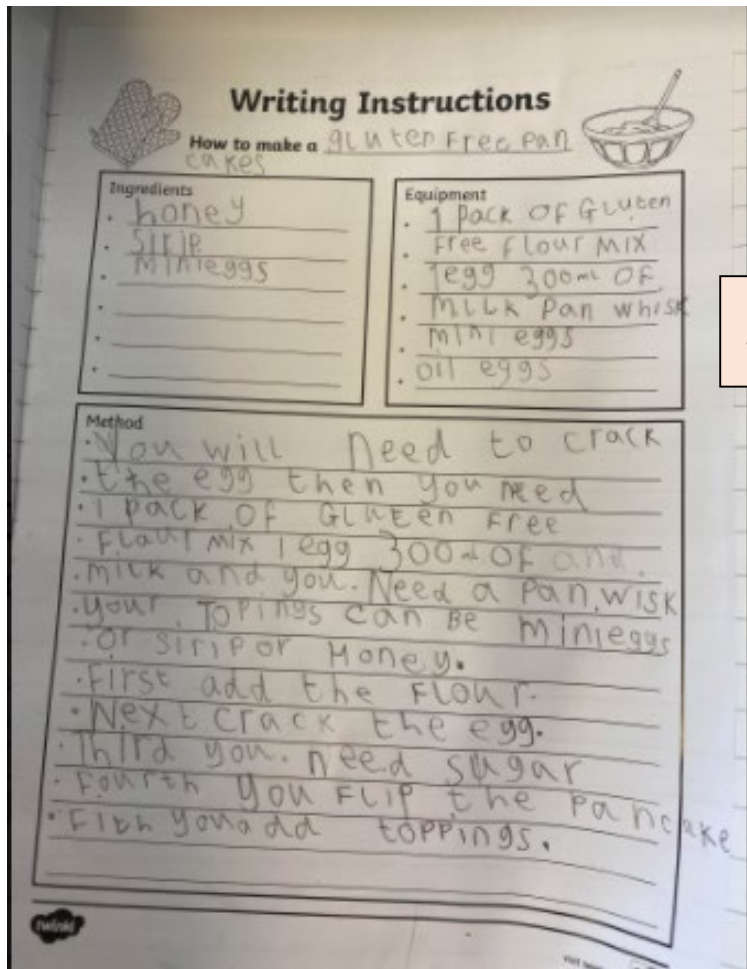


WONDERFUL WRITING DURING REMOTE LEARNING
