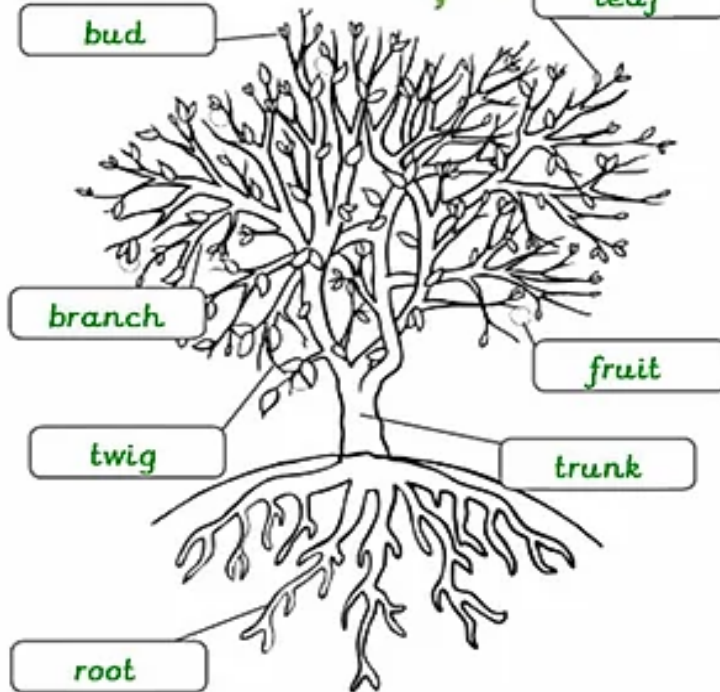

Others grow from seeds, such as foxgloves and wood anemones.



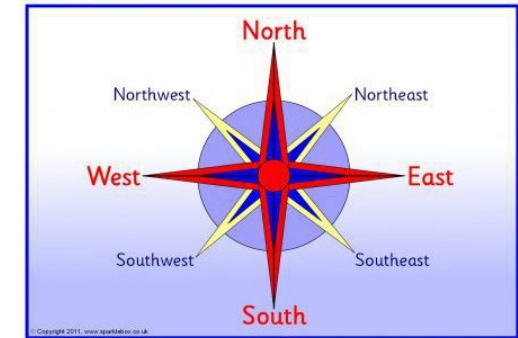

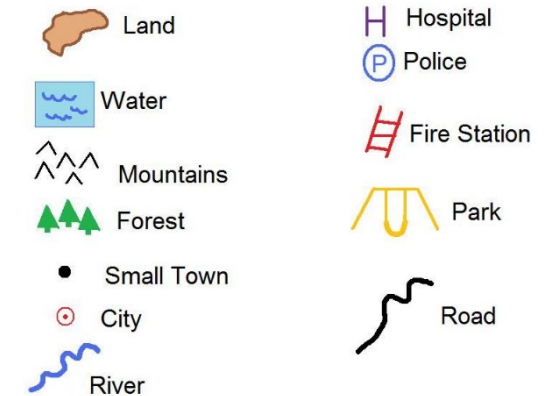

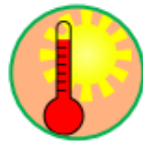
