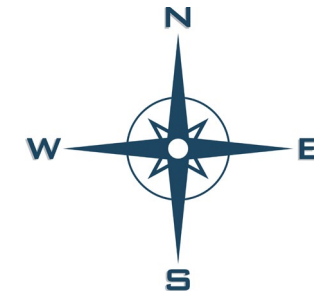

Physical Geography

The natural features of a place or environment

- beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather

Human Geography

Features of an environment that have been shaped by people.

- city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop

Key Vocabulary

county	A small area of the UK containing lots of towns and villages.
climate	The usual or average weather conditions over a long period of time.
continent	A large landmass made up of many countries.
country	An area that is controlled by its own government.
rural	Countryside or farmland.
urban	Towns and cities.
physical feature	A feature that has been formed by nature.
human feature	A feature that has been made or changed by humans.
weather	The specific atmospheric conditions on a given day including temperature and rainfall.
