Subject	Area of learning
Maths 	This half term we will be learning about 2d and 3d shapes, together with Place Value and Addition and Subtraction within 20.
English 	Core texts: We will change our core text weekly, reading a variety of texts from different genres, such as Insect Detective, Pet Poems plus many more! Writing outcomes: writing simple, phonetically plausible sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
History 	Victorians - Over this half term we will begin to explore the Victoria era. We will learn about Victoria Toys and what life was like in the Victorian era.
Geography 	This half term we will be learning about our school, exploring the school grounds, and creating simple maps.
Science 	Technology and the Physical World - We will be learning about electricity, who invented the light bulb, together with learning about different materials.
Computing 	Programme (Coding) – we will be looking at coding simple programs such as Scratch Junior. E-Safety - Also this term we will be learning about e-safety and how to stay safe online.
RE 	This half term we will learning about Religious Stories
PSHE 	Dreams and Goals
